Derrick has over 25 years profession experience covering the areas of public policy; consulting; business strategy and payments.

Trained as an applied economist he began his career with the Government of Canada as an economist working in Policy Branch of the Ministry for Agriculture and Food for six years. After competing his MBA at CEIBS in Shanghai, he transitioned to the private sector working with working at Datamonitor as “Lead Analyst – Innovation and Technology in Financial Services”.

He moved into the field of payments when he joined Visa as Senior Strategy Manager for CEMEA as part of the President’s office, before moving on to become Head of Interchange for the CEMEA region. In this role he was responsible for strategic management of CEMEA’s interchange methodologies and policies aimed at sustaining client bank profitability and Visa’s long-term business objectives for over 80 markets.

After almost 10 years with Visa, Derrick joined WorldPay in 2012 as the Head of Payments at WorldPay, where he was the senior leadership team member responsible for payment scheme relationship management & compliance; payment security; interchange and industry relations. In recognition of the increasing importance of regulation in the payments industry globally, Derrick assumed a new role with Worldpay in 2015 as Head of Industry and Regulatory Affairs to lead group strategy and efforts in this area.
