Ondřej Kovařík is a member of the European Parliament. He is Rapporteur on the Payment Services Directive (PSD3) and Shadow Rapporteur on the Payment Services Regulation (PSR).

Mr Kovařík is a member of the Committee on Economic and Monetary Affairs (ECON), and the Delegation for relations with Canada. He is a substitute member of the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs (LIBE), Subcommittee on Tax Matters (FISC), Delegation to the EU-UK Parliamentary Partnership Assembly, and the Delegation for Northern cooperation and for relations with Switzerland and Norway and to the EU-Iceland Joint Parliamentary Committee and the European Economic Area (EEA) Joint Parliamentary Committee.

He was the rapporteur on the recommendations to the Commission on digital finance's emerging risks in crypto-assets, regulatory and supervisory challenges in the area of financial services, institutions and markets. He was shadow rapporteur on regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on information accompanying transfers of funds and certain crypto-assets, and on the regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on markets in crypto-assets.

His focus is on SMEs, Capital Markets Union, Brexit, market structure, AMLD and FinTech. He was a former coordinator of the ANO delegation in the European Parliament and Deputy Director in the Office of the Czech Government in the EU Council.
